Is any paper allowed on windows in public classrooms (either portable or permanent buildings)? If so, what guidelines apply?

Yes. Paper may be applied to windows of both permanent and/or portable classrooms. However, consideration should be given to the amount of paper applied to both windows and/or walls in classrooms so as not to create a “fire hazard” as determined by the fire authority having jurisdiction and defined in Section 3.14 of Title 19, California Code of Regulations.
