SB1781, Chapter 496, signed into law 9/14/2004 by Governor Schwarzenegger, deletes flame throwing devices from the definition of destructive devices and requires the SFM to adopt regulations governing the possession and use of such devices. This bill prohibits the use or possession of such device without a valid permit, makes a violation of the prohibition a crime and authorizes the SFM to impose fees to cover the administrative costs and enforcement of this act. This is a notice of proposed rule-making for the above legislation.
