

**NOTICE OF 15-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED RULEMAKING
OF THE
OFFICE OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL
TO THE
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS –TITLE 19**

The State Fire Marshal (SFM) is providing notice of changes made to proposed adoption of regulations to the California Administrative Code (CCR), Title 19, Division 1, Chapter 1.5 (Construction Materials and Equipment Listings) which were the subject of written comments from the initial 45 day public comment period that began on December 10, 2010 and ended on January 24, 2011. The State Fire Marshal is proposing to amend California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 19, Section 212 to clarify labeling requirements for SFM listed carbon monoxide devices.

WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

The State Fire Marshal will accept written comments regarding these proposed changes for at least 15 days beginning February 18, 2011 and ending March 5, 2011. All written comments must be submitted to the SFM no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 5, 2011.
