

**NOTICE OF 15-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED RULEMAKING

CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS –TITLE 19**

The State Fire Marshal (SFM) is providing notice of changes made to proposed adoption of regulations to the California Administrative Code (CCR), Title 19, Division 1, Chapter 3 (Fire Extinguishers) which were the subject of written comments from the initial 45 day public comment period that began on October 29, 2010 and ended on December 13, 2010. The State Fire Marshal is proposing to amend California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 19, Section 557.19 and 560.4 to clarify marking and licensing requirements for SFM licensed company vehicles.

**WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD**
