Unapproved Portable Fire Extinguishers Sold in California



It has come to our attention that First Alert is selling unapproved portable fire extinguisher in California. The Tundra fire extinguishers manufactured by BRK Brands and marketed by First Alert do not meet the approved standard for sale in California.

Sales of unapproved fire extinguisher in California constitute a violation of Section 13162 of the Health and Safety Code which states that no person shall market, distribute, or sell any portable fire extinguisher in California unless it has been examined by and bears the label of Underwriters' Laboratories' Laboratories or another testing laboratory approved by the State Fire Marshal.
