# Get involved or be left out!

Who determines if your workplace is safe? Building and fire codes have a lot to say about it. And your vote does count.

The next generation of building and fire safety codes will be decided through online voting. The [International Code Council's new cdpACCESS](#) empowers you to vote on these codes, even if you can't attend the code meetings.

Here are **three simple steps** to be able to cast your vote:

- 1) Make sure your department is a member and signed up to vote, [click here](#). And if your department is already a member, [click here](#).
- 2) Update your department's "**designated voting representatives**" within the International Code Council process. This must be completed annually and maintains your voting eligibility.
- 3) [Cast your votes on code change proposals](#), using the new remote voting process when cdpACCESS voting opens in May and October, 2015.

**IMPORTANT:** To be eligible, you must be an ICC voting member **[before March 20, 2015](#)**, for the upcoming code hearings on the **2018 Group A Codes**.

**Group A Committee Action Hearings:** April 19-30, 2015, in Memphis, TN.  
Online voting will be approximately May 11-22.

**Group A Final Public Comment Hearings:** September 30 – October 7, 2015, Long Beach, CA. Online voting will be approximately October 19-30.
