TWO - DAY HAZARDOUS LIQUID PIPELINE SAFETY SEMINAR

The Office of the State Fire Marshal has joined forces with the U.S. Department of Transportation's Pipeline and Hazardous Material Safety Administration (PHMSA) to conduct a 2-day seminar at the Del Mar Hilton in San Diego County on April 2 & 3, 2008.

Once every three years, the CSFM hosts a Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Seminar conducted by instructor(s) from PHMSA to provide industry training on the federal pipeline safety regulations. This two day seminar will include the federal rulemaking process, 49 CFR Part 195, and layout of the significant subparts, sections, paragraphs, dates and definitions applicable to Part 195. Additional topics to be discussed will include Operator Qualification, Integrity Management, and API RP 1162, Public Awareness Programs for the Pipeline Operator.

A portion of the first day will be used by SFM staff to explain and discuss California specific policies and procedures, such as requesting waivers, taking pipelines out-of-service and encroachment issues.

This seminar will be of interest to pipeline industry personnel as well as local and state agency personnel who wish to gain a better understanding of the regulations that pertain to the safe operation of the 5500 miles of hazardous liquid pipelines that crisscross the state of California.
