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**CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS FOR THE
 CALIFORNIA FIRE SERVICE TRAINING AND EDUCATION SYSTEM
 FIRE FIGHTER I/II CURRICULUM UPDATE AND TEST BANK DEVELOPMENT CADRE**

State Fire Training (SFT) continues to revise several certification standards and courses within the state certification system. We are soliciting help from subject matter experts from the California fire service to participate in these projects as cadre members.

As subject matter experts, cadre members play a key role in evaluating, developing, and validating curriculum document content, and anticipating how curriculum changes will impact the various audiences that use or interact with SFT curriculum and processes. The work to complete these projects comes in two phases: development and validation.

SFT is forming a cadre to update the Fire Fighter I/II Standards and Curriculum. The cadre will update the curriculum to reflect the changes in the 2019 edition NFPA 1001: Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications and the 2017 edition of NFPA 1072: Standard for Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction Emergency Response Personnel Professional Qualifications. Additionally, the cadre will develop and validate the Fire Fighter I/II cognitive exam. **The deadline to submit cadre applications is November 9, 2018.**

Cadre Meetings

During these meetings, which occur over several multiday sessions, eight to ten cadre members work with a cadre lead and an editor to fully develop a curriculum documents, including a Certification Training Standard guide, Course Plans, Capstone Task Book, and skill sheets. Additionally, the cadre will develop and validate 4 test banks for the Fire Fighter I and II cognitive exams. The Cadre Meetings operate like hands-on workgroups, with active participation from all members in analyzing and developing content and anticipating its impact. Cadre members are expected to:

- Have significant expertise in the field addressed by the job function certifications
- Be available to attend all scheduled meetings
- Be willing to review all documents prior to the meeting and come prepared with comments and questions
- Be willing to complete post-meeting assignments
- Represent a cross-section of the fire service participating in or impacted by the field addressed by the job functions certifications
- Be committed to completing any other pre- and post-meeting assignments

Participation

All meetings are held in Sacramento, CA. Funding for cadre member expenses is provided by State Fire Training. All travel, room and board expenses will be facilitated by and paid directly by California State University, Sacramento; per diem and mileage will be reimbursed by CSUS.
