Santiago Fire Shelter Deployment

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Format: Group

Timeframe: 0:30

Description

This activity provides students with an opportunity to listen to radio communication from an actual wildland near-miss incident to identify both positive and negative aspects of the incident and to discuss how improvements can be made.

Materials

- Santiago Fire Shelter Deployment video and radio communication

Instructions

4. Select a spokesperson for your group.
5. Be prepared to discuss your conclusions with the class.
