Introducing: eNFIRS



The US Fire Administration (USFA) has updated the NFIRS reporting system.

eNFIRS is a new, web-based NFIRS 5.0 application.

On January 1st, 2021, agencies who use the Data Entry Tool (DET) will transition to eNFIRS.

eNFIRS Users (Formerly DET Users)

- The NFIRS 5.0 software is now on a new platform.
- Users can access incident reporting tools from any device through the internet on the eNFIRS system.
- Users will no longer export files and email them to us. Incidents will be entered directly into the national database via the eNFIRS reporting system.
- Users can reset their own passwords through eNFIRS.



Vendor Software Users

Vendor software users will continue to send files to CalStats@fire.ca.gov at the end of each quarter.

Active DET accounts were ported over to the eNFIRS system. Account holders can reset their password, login, and start entering incident data using the above link on January 1, 2021.

eNFIRS functions best through Microsoft Edge and Internet Explorer. Each account can only have one email address assigned and this email must be kept current, as it is used to reset the account password.
