eNFIRS Account Registration is Now Required for Third-Party Vendor Software Users

This flyer is a reminder to complete your 2021 NFIRS reports.

2021 Quarter 4 files were due by January 15th.

Please do not resend your files.

Upload them to eNFIRS if you have not done so already.

California NFIRS Data Collection Procedures

The OSFM has made changes to how we collect data from fire departments who use vendor software programs to complete their NFIRS incident reports. These fire departments must upload their NFIRS files directly to the national database using the eNFIRS Bulk Import Utility (BIU) on a **monthly** basis.

This change does NOT apply to fire departments who use the free eNFIRS online software to complete incident reports.

To prepare for this change, you must register for an eNFIRS account.

There are two steps to the process:

If you have already done this, no action is needed.

We will not be able to approve your account until you have completed BOTH steps.
